## The Beast

The Bible speaks about the Beast rising from the sea having ten horns and seven heads <sup>437</sup>. Knowing that "in the beginning … the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters", we can assume that no creation of any Beast can escape His attention. The seven heads can be understood as the seven energy centers called chakras, and the ten horns can be a clue to the ten points of view in these seven heads. logic, geometry, arithmetic, music, astronomy, ...) humans master, or mastered once, or will master in future needs a technical dictionary to separate water from water. present, and the focus gets stuck somewhere in the past or in an imaginary future. Recalibrating Man to the present is the great task of the age at any given time.
